

STORAGE AND HANDLING:	Store desiccated at \leq 4 °C and protect from light especially when in solution.
APPLICATION:	DiBAC ₄ (3) is a so-called translational membrane potential dye that redistributes within the cell membrane when membrane potential changes. ^{1,2} The fluorescence of the dye is enhanced when the dye enters the cell membrane as a result of membrane depolarization. The rate of fluorescence response of the dye to membrane potential change is usually slower than that of the styryl dye di-4-ANEPPS, but the fluorescence signal change for the former is significantly larger than for the latter dye.
